There are 2 course sites that Freshmen have been given access to and freshmen should complete the modules in both these course sites.

Details are as follows:

21S1_CCL-CORE: Co-curricular Learning: Core Modules (Compulsory)

This course site contains 3 compulsory modules that <u>all freshmen must complete by the end of semester 1</u>:

- Fostering a Community of Respect (to be completed before / during TOP where possible)
- Foundational Leadership (to be completed any time before the end of the semester)
- Academic Integrity (preferably to be completed at the start of the semester)

Those who do not complete these 3 modules will not be able to access their exam results.

21S1_CCL-FRESH: Co-curricular Learning: Freshmen Transition and Orientation

This course site contains materials that will be useful for freshmen's transition into University life.
